THE CAMPUS

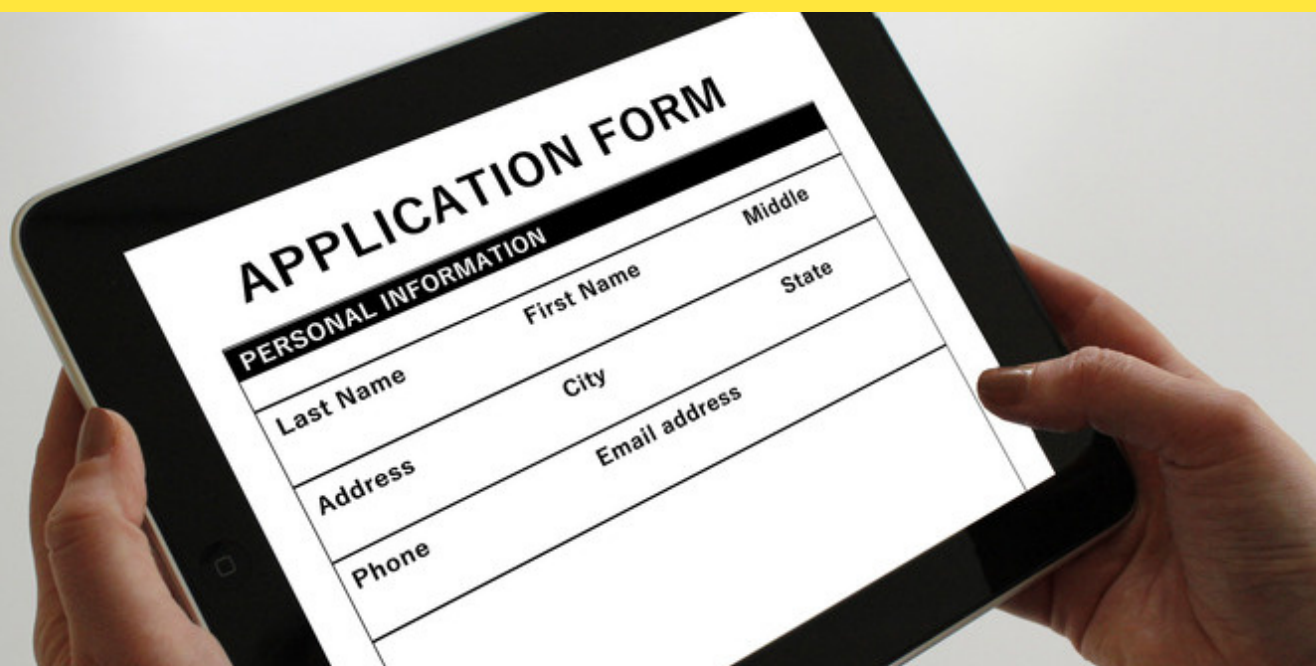
Taganrog is called the «Russian Silicon Valley» for a reason. There are over 200 IT companies working in the city.

HOW TO APPLY

The admission for the master's program «IT management» is carried out in the form of an interview on the submitted portfolio of the applicant. The interview may be conducted in person or remotely over the Internet.



A full IT Management Master's degree application along with undergraduate Bachelor's degree or the equivalent includes the following:

- **Motivation letter**
- **Essay**
- **Results of educational activities**
- **Results of professional, scientific and research activities**



The motivation letter should disclose the reasons for choosing this master's program and the goals that the applicant sets for himself when studying for this master's program. The essay is a detailed scientific answer to one of the proposed topics. The essay should contain a justification of the relevance, current state, main achievements and prospects for the development of the chosen field of research. The results of educational activities include online courses certificates, certificates of English language proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS etc), results of olympiads. Results of professional, scientific and research activities may be presented in form of scientific publications, patents, grants of the applicant.
